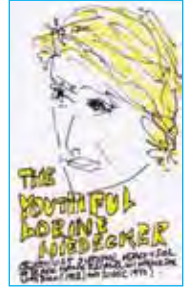

“If I could only stay asleep” is just how Patsy Cline sings it and this visual memoir of drawings of a poetry life follows suit with *Poets Who Sleep*. How I came upon that title many years ago, I can't recall. It became one of my small press monikers as an editor along with *Our Poets Workshop*, *Workshop*, *Scout*, *Just So Happens* and finally all under the umbrella of Longhouse to this day. These poets sleep with me, may sleep with you, sleep with all of us, if we so allow. Many were/are friends, many I published, certainly all I read and advocate, and over the spring, summer, fall and winter of 2017-2018 I drew these portraits, often late into the night reading and listening to the granfalloon by the mutts in the executive branch of the U.S. government. I must have thought the world needed more poets and singers, as I did in my earlier book *Lunatic Drawings* where some of my earliest poet portraits were drawn to sweeten the political mug shots of that book. Don't be surprised who wasn't drawn in this book, because I already am. The portraits came to me as my memory worked over 50 years of recollection — also outdoors where Susan and I would travel the back hills to land by some water freshet to read and draw. Simple days. I wanted to catch the spirits as they flew by. I had a net. Nabokov once ate two butterflies while catching his beloved species during a visit to Vermont with his famous butterfly net. I caught my butterfly poets where I have forever worked and loved. You see, poets will always be with us.
